# <u>Assistance Provided to Individuals Stranded in Sri Lanka on</u> <u>Account of the Conflict in Ukraine</u>

# **The Position of Sri Lanka**

The Foreign Ministry of Sri Lanka on the 25<sup>th</sup> of February, 2022 released a statement expressing its concern about the said conflict and called upon all parties to exercise maximum restraint while working towards peace through diplomacy and sincere dialogue.

In addition to this, Sri Lanka has taken steps to assist the citizens whose countries are involved in this conflict who are currently in Sri Lanka, primarily focusing on providing humanitarian assistance.

# 1. Ukraine-Colombo Coordination Office in Sri Lanka

On the 3<sup>rd</sup> of March, 2022, the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of Sri Lanka released a statement that in order to provide a wide array of assistance to Ukrainian nationals in Sri Lanka including financial, humanitarian and legal help, the Ukraine-Colombo Coordination Office has been established.

# 2. Extension of Visas

On the 3<sup>rd</sup> of March, 2022, the Controller General of the Department of Immigration and Emigration informed the public by way of media release that Ukrainian tourists who had valid tourist visas as at 21. 02. 2022 will have their visas extended free of charge for up to two months from that date. This extension will also apply to Russian tourists in the same category.

Furthermore, it was assured that necessary facilities will be provided for these tourists to exit Sri Lankan airports without any hindrance on their return journey to their respective home countries.

### 3. Accommodation Provided by Private Individuals

In addition to the above efforts, many posts have appeared on social media of individuals offering their boutique hotels, guest houses and even individual rooms to tourists whose homes are in the midst of this conflict and have therefore, been left stranded in Sri Lanka.
